Dear All,

You are all aware of recent reports on the spread of the Coronavirus. The virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person and from contact with infected surfaces or objects.

As a reminder, there are certain steps that we all can take to protect ourselves and our fellow cast and crew members from infection:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid shaking hands – use a fist bump, elbow bump, etc.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash. If tissue is not available, cough/sneeze into elbow.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.

We will have sanitation stations set up at craft service, catering, on set, and in the production office.

If you're feeling sick with fever, cough, or difficulty breathing, please seek medical care right away and inform your supervisor prior to showing up at work. Before going to a doctor's office or emergency room, call and inform them of symptoms.

If the aforementioned symptoms persist, please do not return to work until having seen a doctor and alert the Production office.


# STOP THE SPREAD OF GERMS

Help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases like COVID-19.


Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
