UPDATE #4 (UPDATE 3-18-2020)

Dear Members, keeping you up to date on a few matters:

Since the latest recommendations from the CDC about public gatherings, President Alan Heim and I decided to err on the side of caution. They have recommended all gatherings of 50 or more people be canceled for the next 8 weeks. In addition, gatherings with fewer than 50 people are advised to adhere to all of the safety guidelines including remaining 6-feet apart from one another, which we do not believe we can adequately accommodate. So, all events, screenings, etc. are now canceled through May 10th.

Beginning 3/18/2020, we are closing both the Los Angeles and New York offices. The staff will be working remotely, and we expect the office to be fully functional. For those on the Industry Experience Roster, Contract Services is temporarily eliminating in-person visits due to the pandemic. There was already a plan underway to no longer be required to file updated I-9s through Contract Services starting in July, but this has been moved up and will start right away. Individual employers will be responsible for doing so as has been the case anyway for most since CSATF started processing them.

Those of you who have been laid-off and put on hiatus, or had your start dates pushed back, we need you to take a moment and fill out a 3-minute survey. We have had a relatively small number respond thus far, and we need to provide this information to the IATSE. The IATSE has been successful at securing a standardized two weeks of pay from our more responsible employers. The IA intends to address those employers who are not following suit.
