COVID-19 RETURN TO WORK SUMMARY (UPDATE 9-29-2020)

Dear Members,

Below you will find a link to an IATSE Summary of the Return to Work Safety Agreement ([emailed on 9/21/2020](#)). Anyone being asked to return to a work environment for any company affiliated with the AMPTP and their subsidiaries (and Netflix) can use this as a basic guideline of what you should anticipate. Other IA term agreements, Independent companies and stand-alone facility agreements will be addressed in the very near future.

Again, as we anticipate many of our members continuing to work remotely for a while, if you are asked to return to work at a worksite and you have any discomfort with any safety protocols being put in place, please reach out to us right away. And, if you are accepting employment and the employer is requiring you to work from home and you are unable to do so, you should also reach out to us for assistance if you are unable to get this resolved.

The IATSE has announced a zero tolerance for members not abiding by the agreed-upon safety protocols. However, the employers must also be held responsible. We must be diligent about the enforcement of the provisions contained within the agreement and monitor issues or problems that arise.

We will be meeting again with the AMPTP in one month, and every two months thereafter, to work through any matters that may not have been anticipated or subject to change as we work through the evolution of the pandemic.
